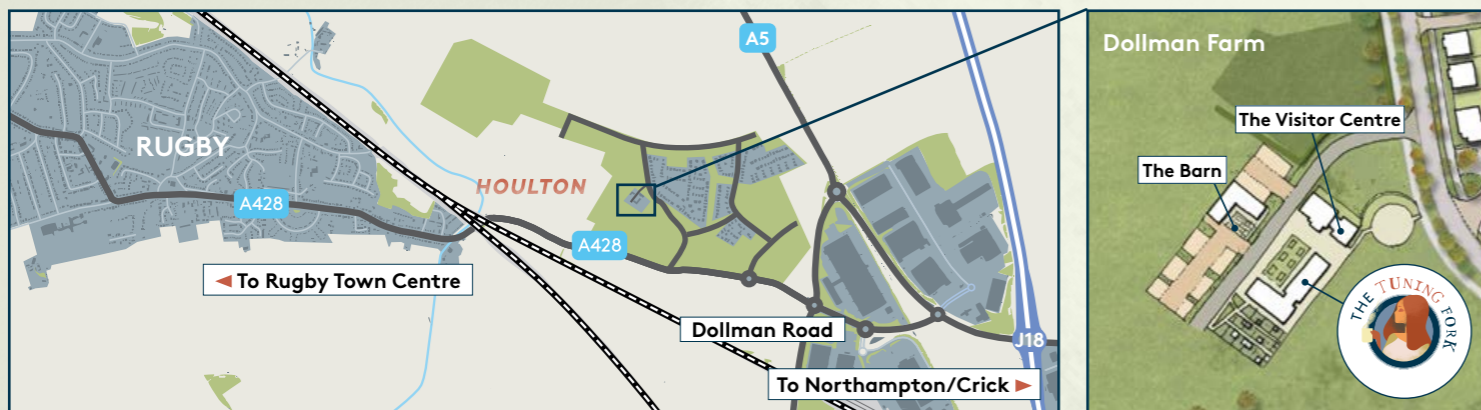

OUR CONTRACTORS

THE CONTRACTOR CARRYING OUT CONSTRUCTION OF THE HOULTON LINK ROAD IS GALLIFORD TRY.

Galliford Try is a local contractor with extensive experience in delivering these kinds of projects within local communities. We have placed a series of requirements on them to be followed during the construction period. This is what you can expect:

- They will comply with specific traffic routes, with no construction traffic passing through the village of Clifton or Hillmorton Locks (more details inside this leaflet)
- Hours of work will be: Monday to Friday – 7.30am – 5.30pm; Saturday – 7.30am – 2pm; Sunday and out-of-hours work – by agreement (see our website for notification of this if it should occur)
- Operations from main compound at Hillmorton Lane and smaller satellite compounds at Butlers Leap and at the eastern end of the road where it connects to Houlton (see plan inside leaflet)
- A duty of care to maintain high standards of behaviour as well as health and safety

Galliford Try follow a Considerate Contractors Scheme and have a point of contact for you during the duration of this project.

- A project as large and complex as the Houlton Link Road will require large machinery. Please be reassured that we will make every effort to keep the levels of disruption to a minimum. We ask you to bear with us throughout the development period.
- Whilst we make every effort to brief our contractors on the correct routes and behaviours there may be instances where errors occur. If you see anything outside of acceptable standards, please inform us – supplying date, time and vehicle registration if possible.
- We will endeavour to notify you should there be any significant changes to plans.

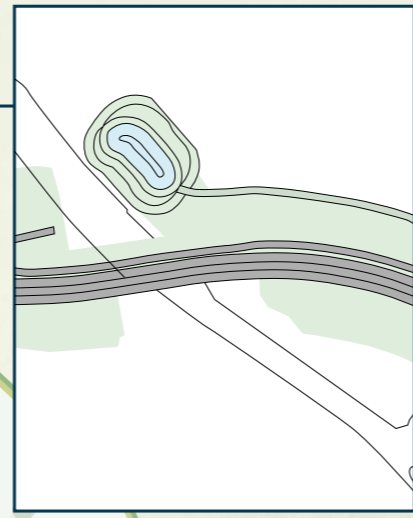
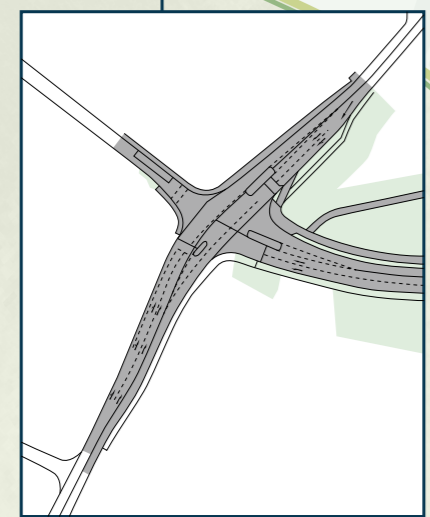
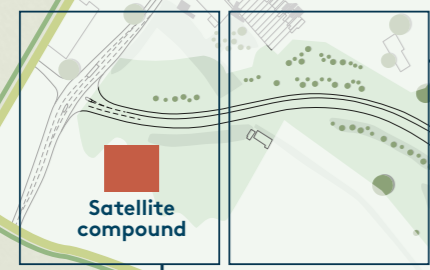


Construction access routes

- A5 - Lilbourne Road - Hillmorton Lane
- A5 - Locks Lane (temporary) - only to junction with Link Road
- No traffic through Clifton village
- No traffic through Hillmorton Locks



No access to construction traffic

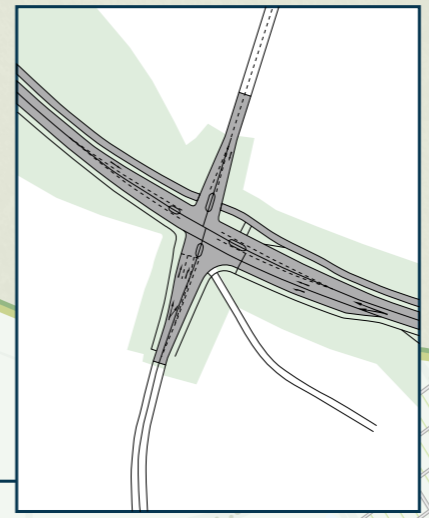


Houlton Bridge

- Timescale: Oct 2017 - June 2018
- Duration of work: 9 months
- What you'll see: new canal bridge and earthworks being constructed over Oxford Canal
- Likely disruption: temporary closure of canal towpath and navigable water

Butlers Leap connection

- Timescale: Sept 2017 - May 2018
- Duration of work: 9 months
- What you'll see: upgrade widening of the existing signalised junction to provide an additional fourth arm to access Link Road. Also an extension to the culvert and a new retaining wall
- Likely disruption: temporary traffic signals, lane closures, large vehicles turning



Hillmorton Lane

- Timescale: Nov 2017 - Mar 2018
- Duration of work: 5 months
- What you'll see: new signalised junction constructed at the junction of Hillmorton Lane and new Link Road
- Likely disruption: closure and temporary diversion of Hillmorton Lane
